COME AND JOIN US FOR AN ARCHAEOLOGICAL DIG!

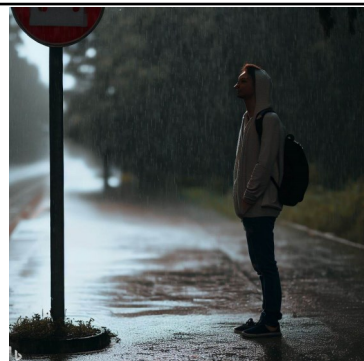
SHAL (Studying History and Archaeology in Lymgne) are announcing their Dig in Lymgne August 2023

This year's dig will be mainly exploratory and research - led to investigate a site at the summit of Lymgne Hill, which has yielded some magnetometry anomalies. There will be opportunities for volunteers to get involved between the 18th and 26th of August 2023, under the supervision of Richard Taylor and Simon Elliott, professional Archaeologists working with SHAL in conjunction with Kent Archaeological Society (KAS)

Please note the site is rocky, steep and overgrown and we will have the company of some young heifers belonging to the landowner, which will be fenced off as far as possible. Therefore this year we will be able to welcome only children of secondary school age and above.

We will be using the Village Hall as a dig headquarters and we will have information and, we hope, photos of our progress available for people to see in the Committee room on a daily basis.



FIGHT FOR NUMBER 10 CONTINUES

The fight continues to save the number 10 bus route through Lymgne, which is threatened for removal from 3rd of September this year. County Councillor Jenni Hawkins, District Councillors John Wing and Jeremy Speakman along with the Parish Council have been in contact with Stagecoach the company currently providing the service through Lymgne and also the KCC transport

department which is headed up by Cllr David Brazier. The Parish Council have received a reply from Stagecoach which does not shed any hope that the bus route will be reinstated however, this matter will not be left by the Parish Council nor the District and County Councillors. One glimmer of hope did appear from the response sent by Stagecoach in that school buses towards Folkestone would be reinstated, however the company cited that the "diversion" through Lymgne (we are not sure when we became a diversion!) carried a time penalty such that to maintain the new timetable another bus would need to be added to compensate for that. They went on to explain that the annual operating costs for a bus are about £150,000 and that there is nothing like that revenue generated by coming through Lymgne. So how do you balance the operating costs with the real life concerns of residents who have contacted the parish council concerned about how they will get to their doctor's appointments and do their shopping. Stagecoach will be stopping in Newingreen but with some residents finding walking to a nearby bus stop hard the thought of walking all the way to Newingreen is a step too far. Stagecoach in their closing comments say that they are committed to working with the Public Transport Team at KCC to explore new sources of funding to develop the local bus route. Let us hope that we are included in that new funding- In the meantime please make your views known. Please contact your County Councillor and District Councillor. Contact details are shown on Page 6 of this news letter.

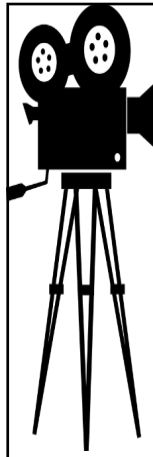
SPECIALIST DOG FOSTERING SERVICE FOR SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC ABUSE

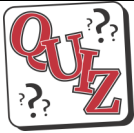

This month we look at a Lympe bound aircraft lost at sea in July 1969 taking the lives of a Doctor and his family.

The Doctor and his Family Lost at Sea

On the 6th July 1969 Michael John Cutler, his wife Audrey and their daughter Sarah took off from Le Touquet in his part owned Jodel DR250/160 Capitaine heading to Lympe. The family home was at 60 Old London Road, Hastings. Dr Culver was described as a colourful personality and a very much liked doctor at a practice in the Old Town and specialising in infant welfare at centres in Hastings and Rye. He also worked in industrial medicine, dermatology and hypnotherapy. In his spare time he loved photography, horticulture, playing squash and flying.

On this day the Jodel aircraft was to come down in the English Channel, and nothing more would be heard from the Cutler family ever again. He had owned G-AVOB since the previous year with two others; Derek Keith Farrant and Rupert John Gyster. It had first been registered to the three of them on 11th April 1968. The British Railways owned car ferry TS Normannia found the aeroplane's wreckage between Dover and Boulogne, but no bodies were present with it.

Michael Culver was educated at Hydneye House prep school in Hastings, the same school Dambuster David Maltby whose bomb brought down the Mohne Dam, attended many years before. He then went to Wrekin College, near Telford, Shropshire before studying further at Guy's Hospital in London. He gained a conjoint diploma in 1943 graduating with MB and BS three years later. That same year he joined his father in the Torfield House practice, taking his DCH in 1948. He was born on 16th December 1916 and was 52 at the time of his death. Sadly no more information about Audrey Cutler or Sarah is known, other than the former's culinary expertise and artistic flare radiated through the home. Not on the flight that day was their son Simon Roy Cutler aged 20. The Jodel's registration was cancelled by the CAA on the 15th July 1969. Some reports claimed he was alone at the time of his death, but a Reuters report confirmed all three were lost on this day and a British Medical Journal, (BMJ) obituary also did likewise. Save for the 1980 parachute school air crash, this was the penultimate incidence of loss of life connected with Lympe Airfield's long history.

KENT GARDENER- Summer is moving along now and earlier colourful displays need a little refurbishment. Dead head flowers as they go over to encourage more blooms but some like salvia nemorosa, primroses, aquilegia, oriental poppies and ground cover geraniums should be cut down to ground level, fed and watered, and they will produce more leaves and possibly a few flowers in the autumn. Trim lavender to about 2.5 cms below the flowering stem to keep it neat but never into brown wood as it won't regrow. Leave some later seed heads to collect for next year's plants or for the birds who do a good job of collecting pests at the same time. Camellias and azaleas will need watering if it is dry as they are now forming next year's flower buds. The vegetable plot should be yielding good results and frequent harvesting should encourage the plants to produce more. Don't forget quick growing crops like rocket and perpetual spinach can be sown now for a late autumn crop. Keep turning the compost heap to hasten decomposition and cover to retain the heat and moisture. Water if too dry. Birds and animals need water so clean the water and food containers regularly. Place a stone projecting above the water level in the dish so bees and butterflies can alight and drink, especially in hot weather. Bushes that have already finished flowering should have been pruned but plums and cherries should not be pruned after the end of August as coral spot fungus is more prevalent in cool damp weather and can damage these trees. Happy gardening.

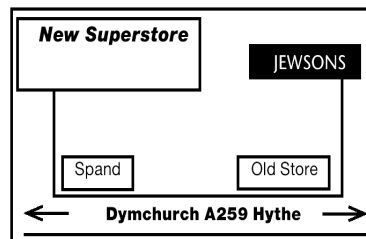
